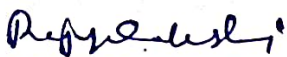

DESCRIPTION:

A field visit to **KSR Handlooms**, located in Chirla, was organized by the **Department of Computer Science, Y.A. Government College, Chirala** for the **I year B.Sc. Honours Computer Science** students. This visit aimed to provide students with a practical insight into the traditional handloom industry and its integration with modern technology and importance of weavers in today's mechanized world.

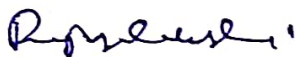
While visiting the Handloom industry the students are divided into 2 batches and each batch consists of 15 members and the manager P.venkat Swami Explains the company profile briefly to the students and staff of Y.A Government college , Chirala. The handloom industry can be broadly divided into sections like yarn production, dyeing and printing, weaving on different types of looms, finishing and embellishment, and product design and marketing. In each Section Weavers demonstrated their techniques, and students got to observe the manual and semi-automated weaving processes.

A session was held to discuss the potential for digital technologies in revamping the handloom sector, such as using machine learning for pattern prediction and design, or incorporating e-commerce to reach global markets. The successful field visit was well coordinated by the Manager P.Venkat swami, and the staff Members of KSR Handlooms, Chirala.

OUTCOME:

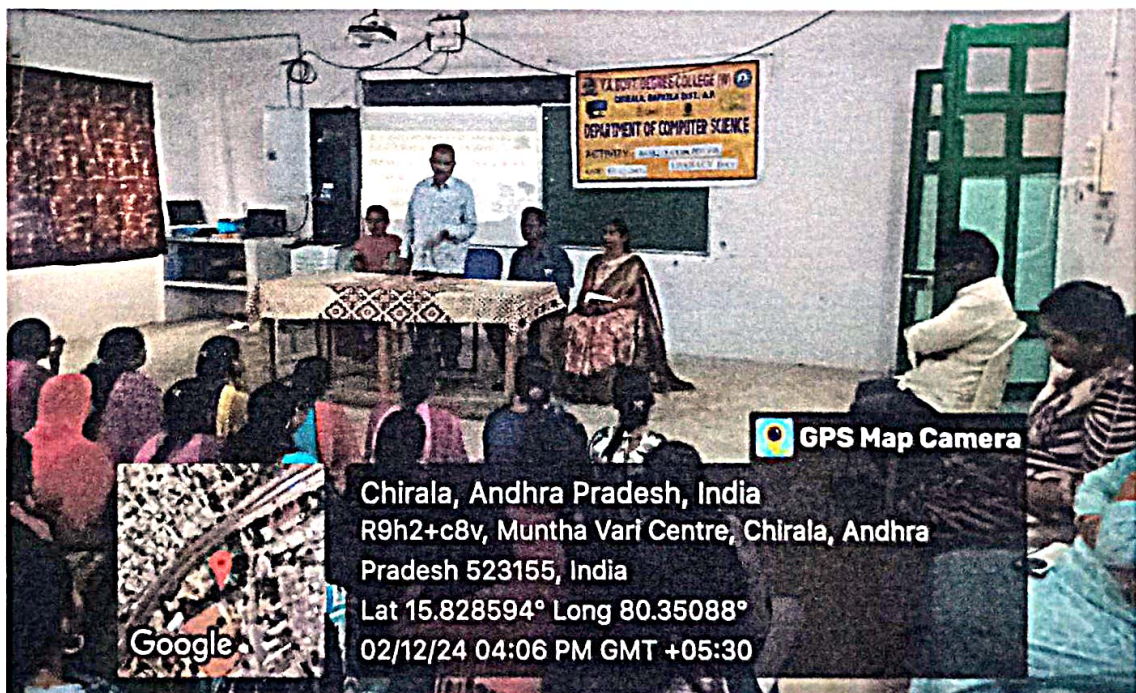

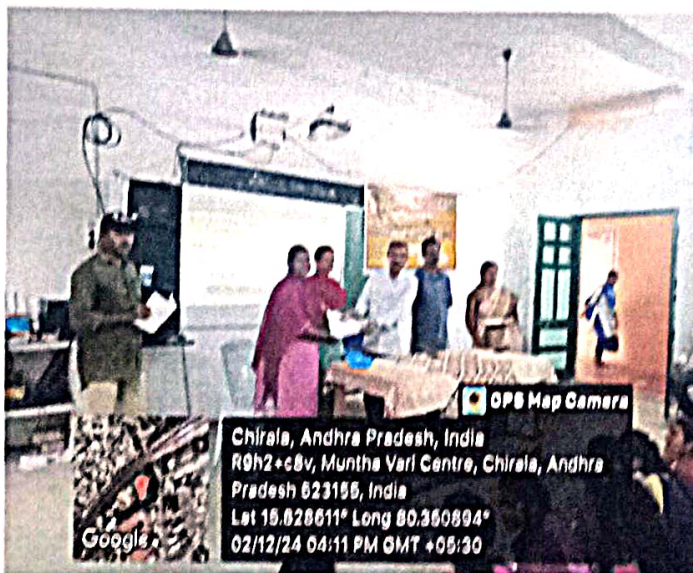
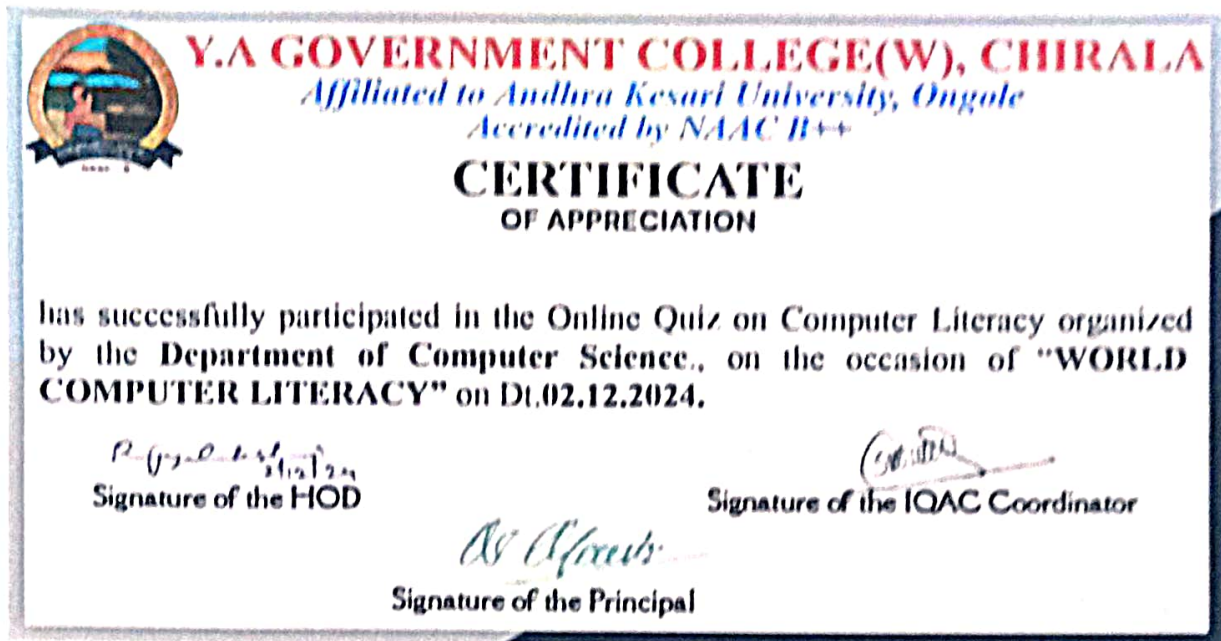

To prepare students for the workplace by familiarizing them with tools widely used in professional settings for communication, file storage, and project management.

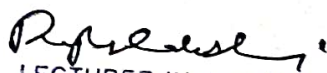
DESCRIPTION:
