Description:

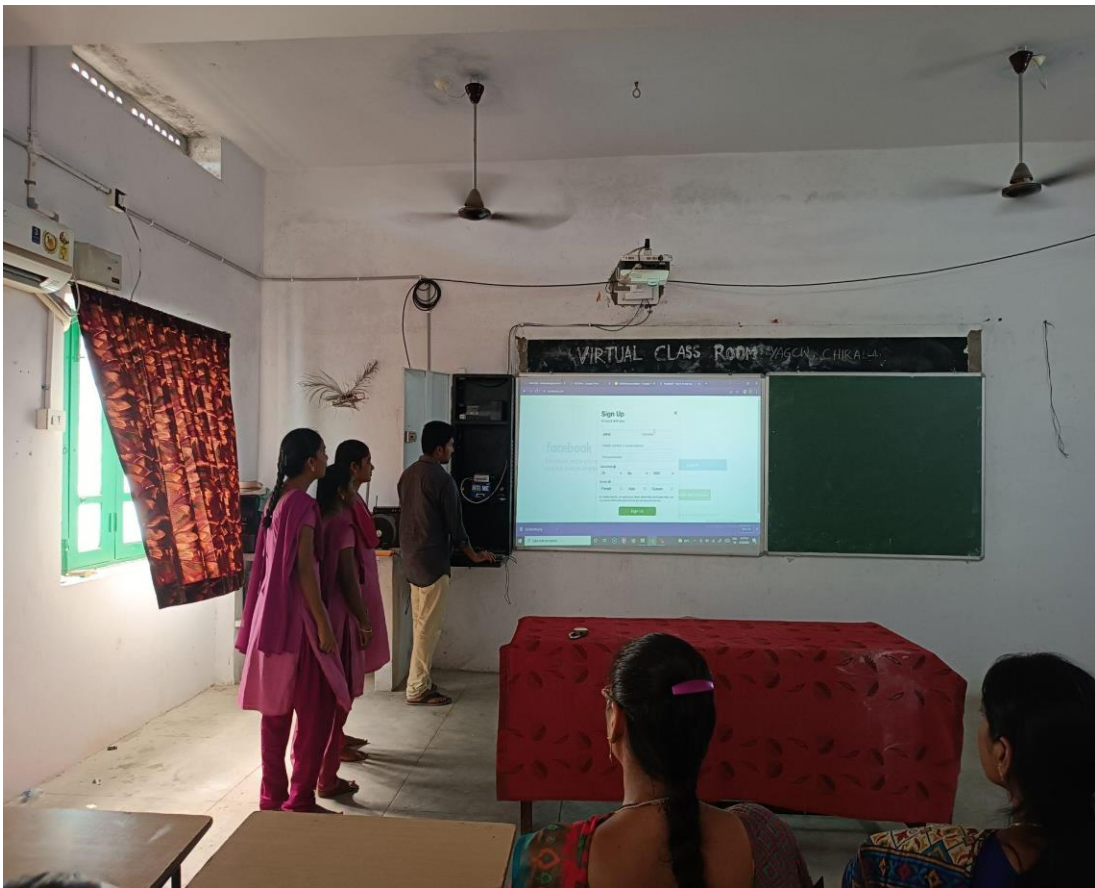

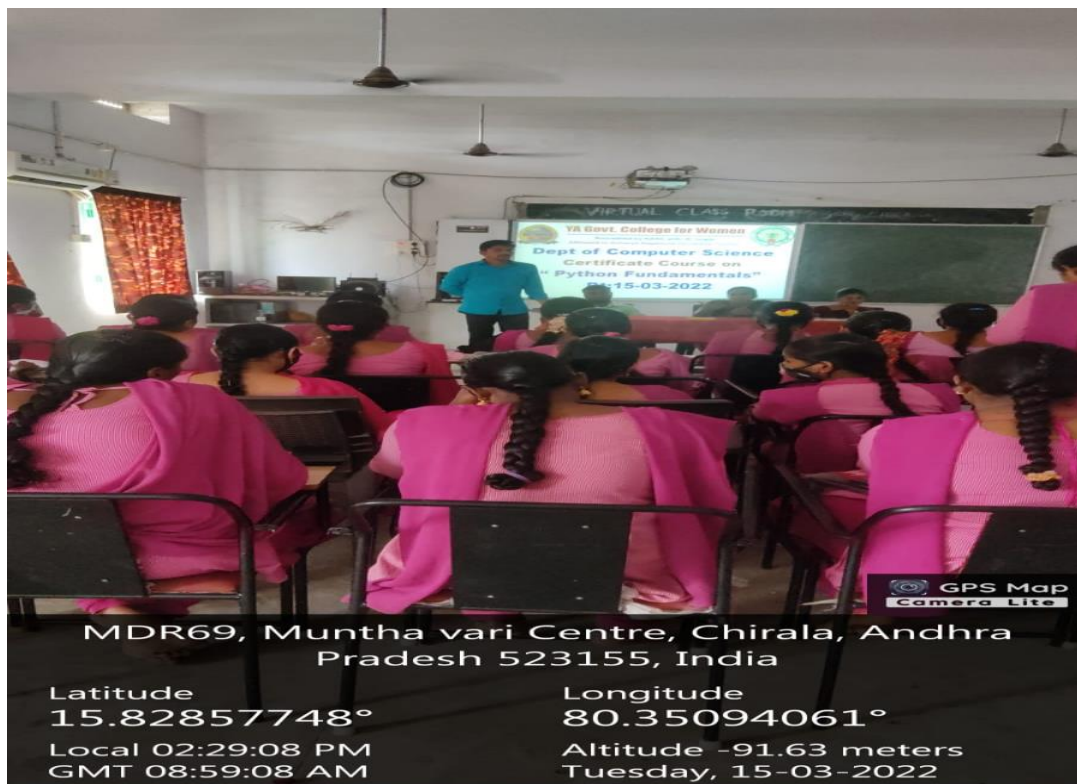
Description:

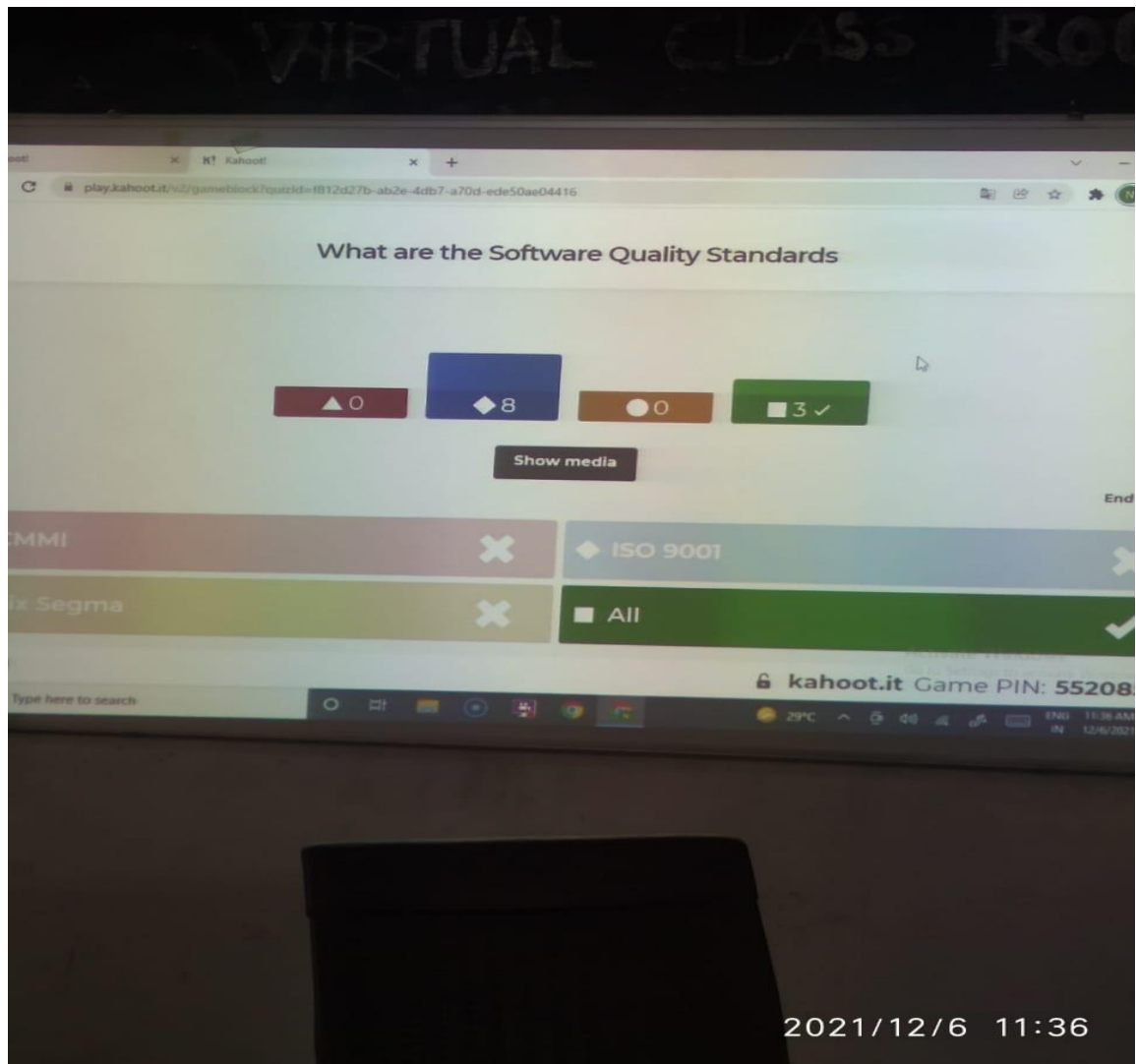

Description:

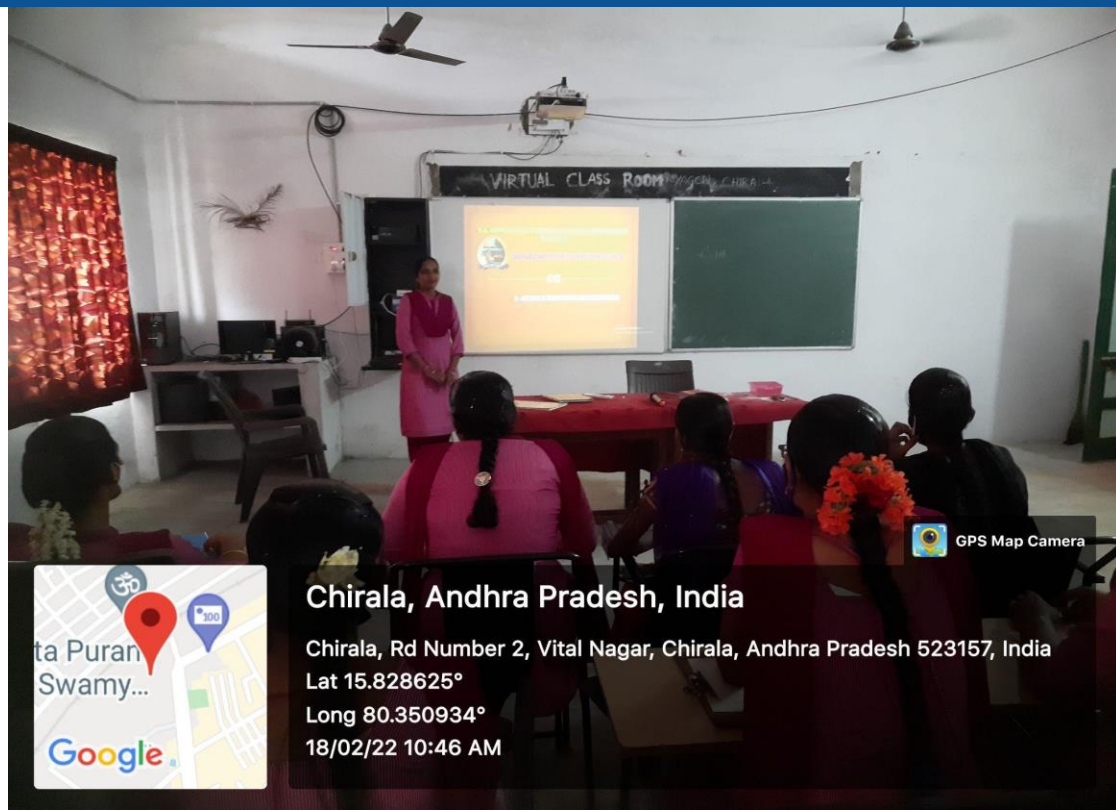
Smt. S.KavyaSri, Lecturer incharge Computer Science conducted the JAM round for I B.Com(Computer) students. Total number of students participating is 25.

Objective:

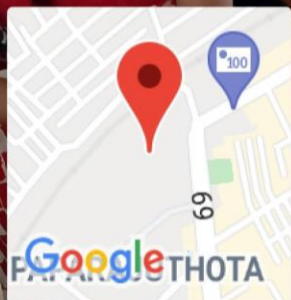

To enhance technical skills and to acquire industrial knowledge.

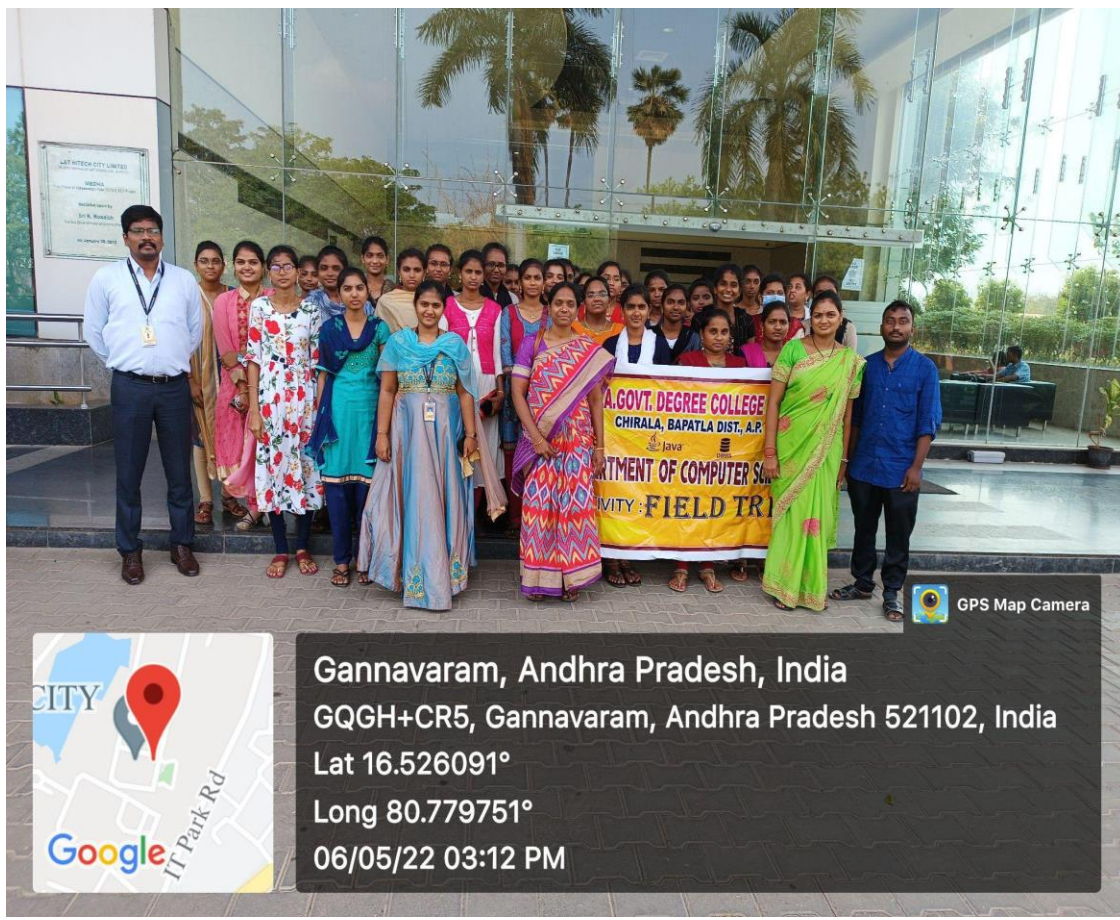
Description:
