विश्व हिन्दी दिवस (10 जनवरी 2023)

विश्व हिन्दी दिवस (10 जनवरी) के अवसर पर डिजिटल क्लास रूम में कार्यक्रम का आयोजन किया गया। इस कार्यक्रम का मतलब हिंदी भाषा के महत्व के बारे में छात्रों को अवगत करने और इसके महत्व को बढ़ावा देने के लिए हिंदी विभाग ने 10 जनवरी को विश्व हिंदी दिवस का आयोजन किया।

हिंदी हमारी राष्ट्रभाषा और राजभाषा है। 14 सितंबर 1949 को संयुक्त राष्ट्र महासभा (United Nations General Assembly) (UNGA) में हिंदी को भारत की आधिकारिक भाषा के रूप में मान्यता दी गई थी। इस कार्य को मनाने के लिए, तत्कालीन प्रधान मंत्री इंदिरा गांधी ने 10 जनवरी 1975 को नागपुर, महाराष्ट्र में पहले विश्व हिंदी सम्मेलन का उद्घाटन किया। यह लगभग 30 देशों के 100 प्रतिनिधियों के साथ 10 जनवरी 1975 से 12 जनवरी 1975 तक आयोजित किया गया था। इस में मुख्य अतिथि के रूप में मॉरीशस के तत्कालीन प्रधान मंत्री (सिवसागुर रामगुलाम) थे। 1975 से भारत, मॉरीशस, यूनाइटेड किंगडम, त्रिनिदाद और टोबैगो, संयुक्त राज्य अमेरिका जैसे विभिन्न देशों में विश्व हिंदी सम्मेलन का आयोजन किया गया। बाद में 2006 में, तत्कालीन पूर्व प्रधान मंत्री डॉ मनमोहन सिंह ने घोषणा की कि हर साल 10 जनवरी को विश्व हिंदी दिवस के रूप में मनाया जाएगा। तब से विश्व हिन्दी दिवस हर साल 10 जनवरी को मनाया जाता है। उसके बाद से भारतीय विदेश मंत्रालय ने विदेश में 10 जनवरी 2006 को पहली बार विश्व हिन्दी दिवस मनाया था। विश्व हिन्दी सचिवालय मॉरीशस में स्थित है।

इसका उद्देश्य विश्व में हिन्दी के प्रचार-प्रसार के लिये जागरूकता पैदा करना तथा हिन्दी को अन्तरराष्ट्रीय भाषा के रूप में पेश करना है। विदेशों में भारत के दूतावास इस दिन को विशेष रूप से मनाते हैं। सभी सरकारी कार्यालयों में विभिन्न विषयों पर हिन्दी में व्याख्यान आयोजित किये जाते हैं। विश्व में हिन्दी का विकास करने और इसे प्रचारित-प्रसारित करने के उद्देश्य से विश्व हिन्दी सम्मेलनों की शुरुआत की गई

आज हमारी भारत सरकार "त्रिभाषा" सिद्धांत का प्रचार कर रही है। इसका तात्पर्य है कि व्यक्ति को अपनी मातृभाषा, राष्ट्रीय भाषा (हिंदी) और अंतर्राष्ट्रीय भाषा (अंग्रेजी) सीखनी चाहिए।

अंग्रेजी विभाग के श्री लूथर जीने इस कार्यक्रम में भाग लिया और छात्रों के ज्ञानवर्धन के लिए भारत में हिंदी भाषा के महत्व पर बात की।

छात्रों ने इस कार्यक्रम में बहुत सक्रियता और उत्साह से भाग लिया।

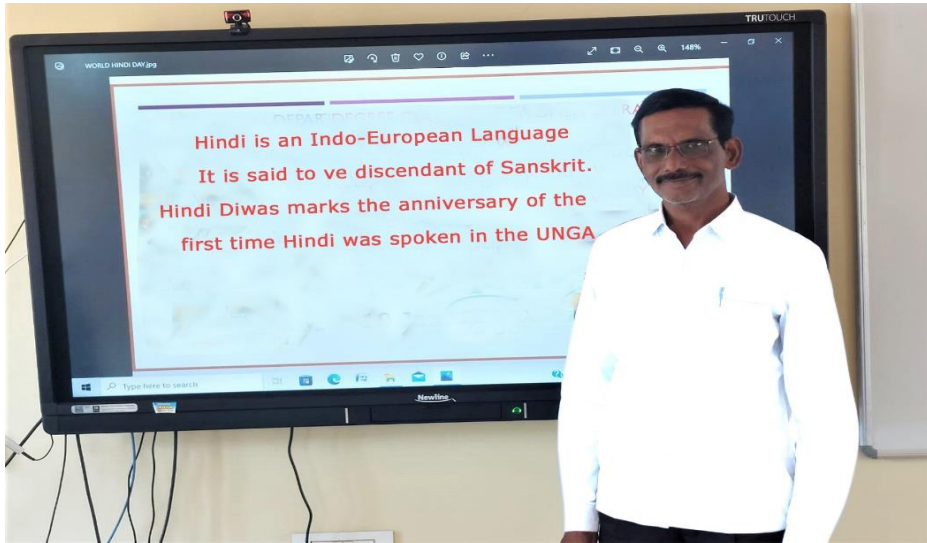
WORLD HINDI DAY (10 JAN. 2023)

Hindi is our National Language (राष्ट्रीय भाषा) and official language (राजभाषा). It was recognized as the official language of India at the UN General Assembly (UNGA) on 14 Sep. 1949. To commemorate this deed, the then Prime Minister Indira Gandhi inaugurated the first “World Hindi Conference” on 10 Jan. 1975 at Nagpur, Maharashtra. It was held from 10 to 12 Jan. 1975. On this occasion, 100 delegates from about 30 countries participated and the then Prime Minister of Mauritius (Seewoosagar Ramgoolam) was the Chief Guest. Later in the year 2006, former Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh announced that 10 January of every year would be celebrated as “World Hindi Day”. From then on, the ‘Indian Ministry of External Affairs’ celebrates this day every year by organising events and activities like poetry readings, quizzes, cultural programs, speech contests, and debates to promote Hindi. Sometimes, the day is also celebrated by the ‘Indian Postal Department’ by issuing special stamps. Our Indian Government is propagating “Thri Bhasha” principle (त्रि भाषा सिद्धांत). This implies one must learn one’s Mother Tongue, National Language (Hindi) and the International Language (English).

World Hindi Day is also known as Vishwa Hindi Diwas. It was the anniversary of the day when Hindi was spoken in the United Nations General Assembly in 1949 for the first time. It is celebrated by Hindi enthusiasts to mark the importance of Hindi as a Global Language and to promote its awareness across the world. It is an occasion to recognize Hindi as a Universal Language.

The World Hindi Conference was held this year with the theme “Hindi - Traditional Knowledge to Artificial Intelligence”.
