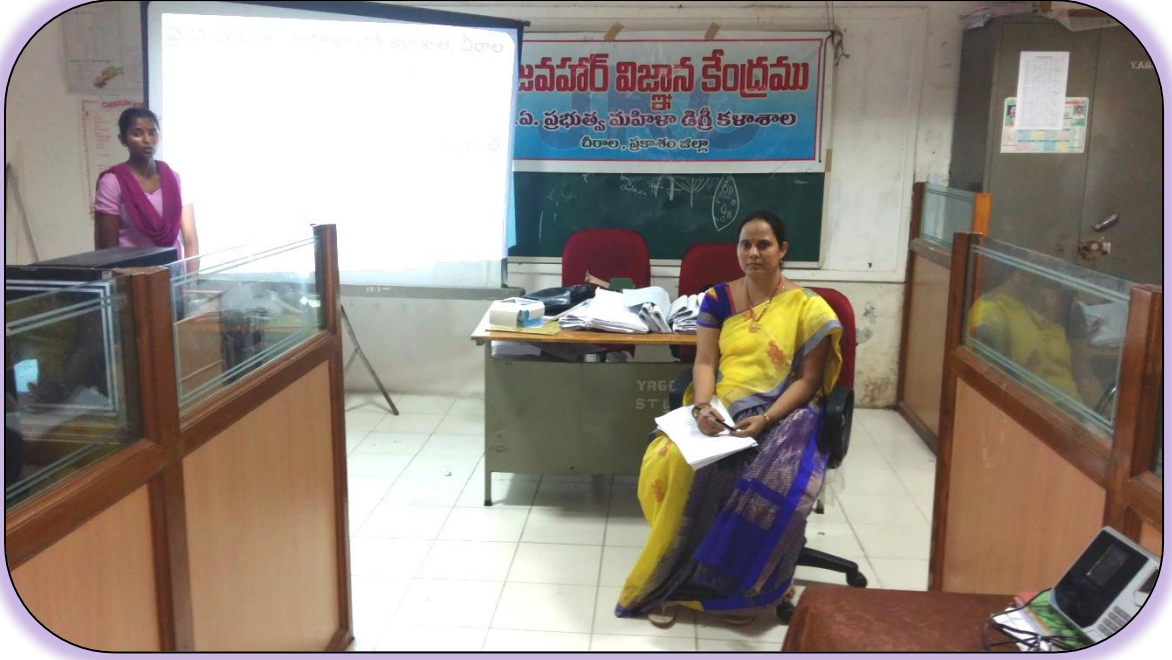
Activity Name: Telugu Bhasha Dinotsavam

Activity Name: Students Field Visit/Study Tour

Date: 21-12-2017

Description: Field visit is organized by Departments of Telugu, English, History, Economics and Political Science to the following places.

1. Firstly, students visited the famous library Saraswatha Nikethanam, Vetapalem to learn and acquire knowledge on how to use the library effectively and efficiently.

Saraswatha Nikethanam is one of the foremost research oriented libraries of Andhra Pradesh. This library, founded by late V.V. Shreshti in 1918 and later on "Pantulu Garu" (Adusumalli Srinivasa Rao) anchored the library, had the rare privilege and good fortune of its foundation stone being laid by The Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi, in 1929. In 1935, then President Babu Rajendra Prasad visited the library. The buildings were opened by Seth Jamnalal Bajaj and Tanguturi Prakasam Pantulu. It has been the fountain of inspiration to the youth during the freedom struggle.





2. Secondly, students visited Cashew nut industry. The students witnessed the cashew nut processing unit and were briefed on drying, peeling, gradation and packaging of the cashew nuts. Cashew nut industry has been thriving in Vetapalem since British times as colonial rulers from Madras Presidency took special care to promote it in the Prakasam district.



3. Lastly, Students visited Veerabhadra Swamy Temple, Motupalli and Motupalli Beach and learned about the importance of Motupalli.

Motupalli had served as an international port during the early and medieval periods. Inscriptions of Kakatiya Ganapathi Deva, Anapotha Reddy of the Kondaveedu dynasty and Deva Raya II of the Vijayanagara dynasty now at the Veerabhadra Swamy temple mention the incentives provided to the sea-borne traders.

Italian traveller Marco Polo, who had visited the port in 1287 AD, had given a vivid account of the flourishing trade activities at the port during the reign of Kakatiya queen Rudrama Devi.

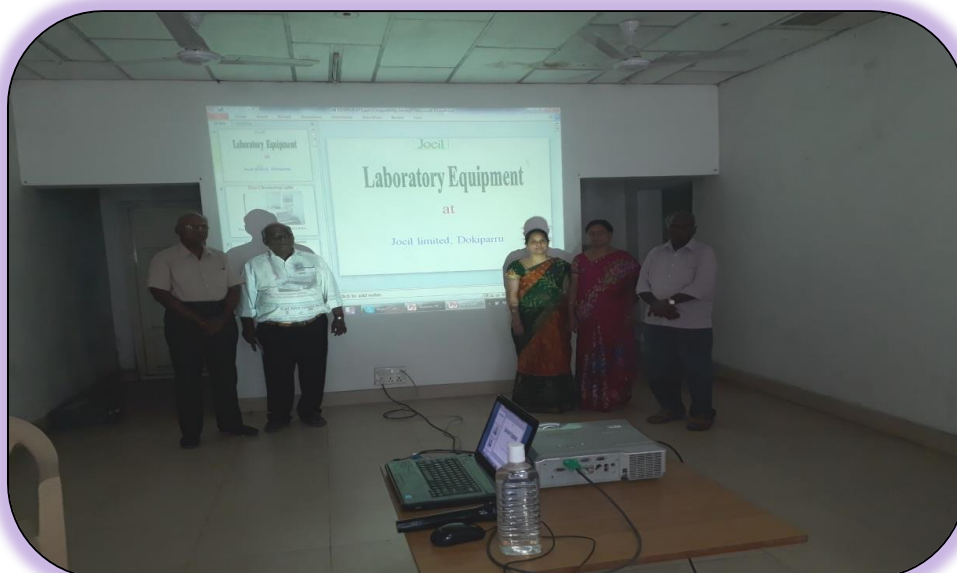
Activity Name: Field Trip to Jocil Factory and Kondavedu Fort

Date: 23-01-2018

Description: II Year Students visited Jocil Limited, Dokiparru on 24-01-2018 as part of their subject Leadership Education.

Students learned about how the company organization is formed, how to form the Teams, how to run the company successfully with good leadership skills, and how to market the products. This visit is beneficial to the students as all the participants will get practical exposure to the factory's working environment.

Jocil has been running for 30 years in the field of manufacture of Stearic Acid Flakes, Fatty Acids, Toilet Soap, Soap Noodles, and Refined Glycerine.



Description: I and II Year Students visited Kondaveedu Fort on 24-01-2018 and learned the following things. Kondaveedu Fort was constructed during Telugu Chodas, strengthened by Kakatiyas, and occupied by Prolaya Vema Reddy, who shifted his capital from Addanki to Kondaveedu in 1323 AD. Later it was taken over by Gajpathis of Orissa and ravaged by the Bahmani Sultans in 1458. The Vijayanagara emperor Krishnadevaraya captured it in 1516. The Golconda Sultans fought for the fort in 1531, 1536, and 1579, and Sultan Quli Qutb Shah finally captured it in 1579, renaming it as Murtuzanagar. Later it was recaptured by the Mughal army of Aurangzeb in 1687, and the fort came under the control of the French colonists in 1752 when it was extensively fortified. It passed on to the English imperialists who got control of the fort in 1788 but abandoned it in the early 19th century in favour of Guntur.

Date: 03-02-2018

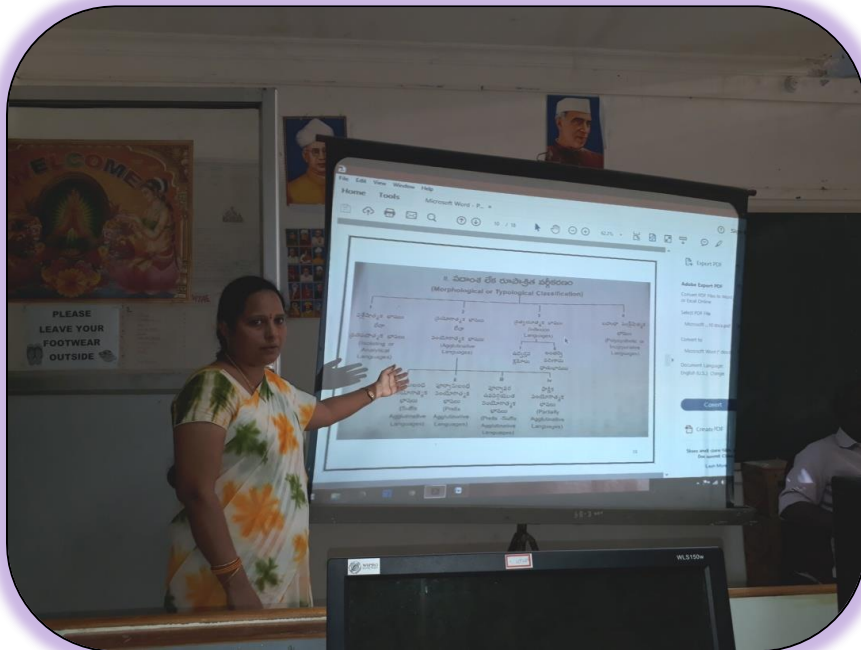
