Name of the Activity: Guest lecture

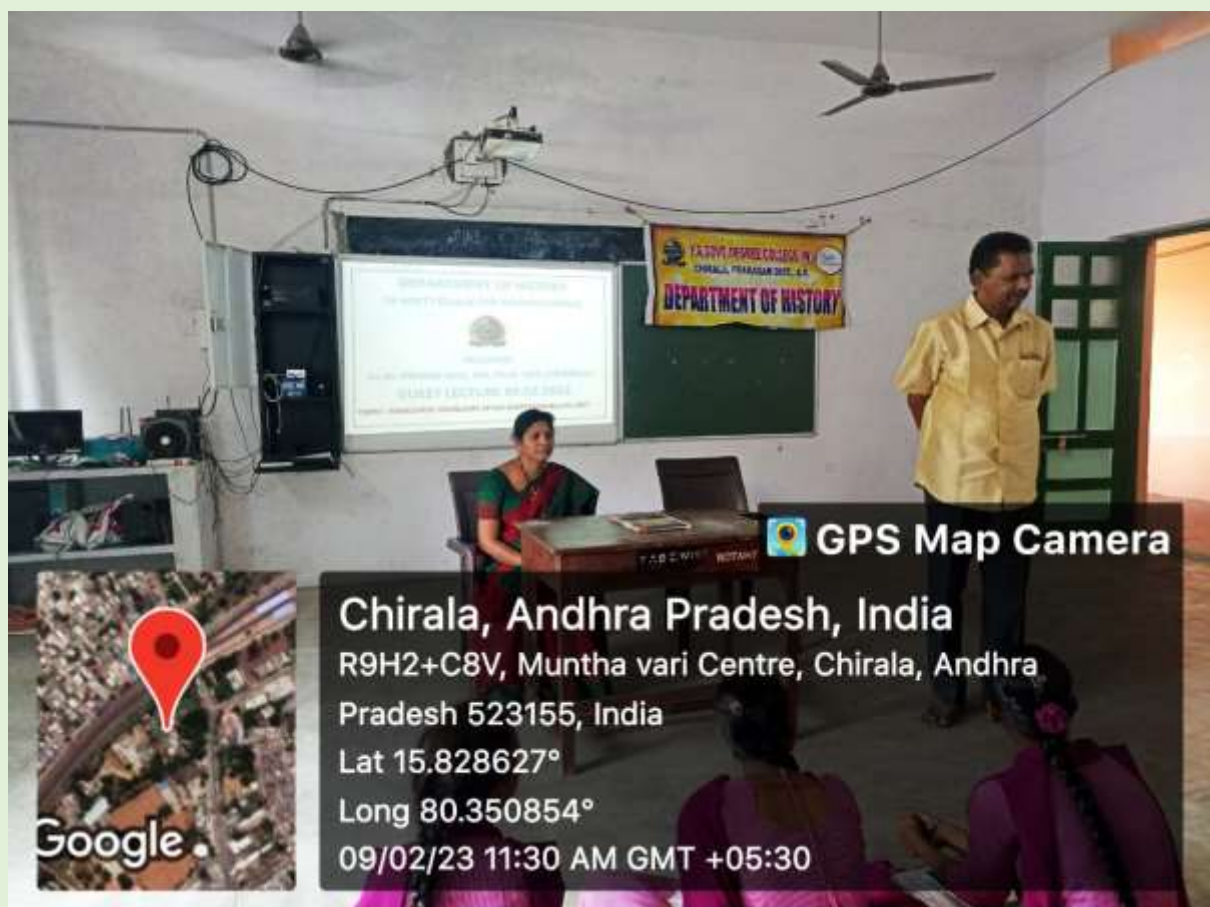
Date: 05-01-2022
