The adjustment of surplus Teaching Staff in Private Aided Colleges in the State is under consideration of the Government for quite some time. It has come to the notice of the Special Commissioner of Collegiate Education, A.P., Vijayawada through various reports of the Internal Audit of this Department and the Regional Joint Directors of Collegiate Education concerned that certain Lecturers/Physical Directors / Librarians working in Private Aided Colleges are being paid their Salaries from the Grant-in-Aid even though they are not having sufficient workload due to uneconomic students strength in various groups and subjects for the last two years. If the lecturers continue in the same places without properly and fully utilizing their services to cater to the educational needs of the students, it leads to misuse and wastage of public funds and loss to State Exchequer. There is a need to shift the students to local /nearby colleges from those colleges wherever uneconomic strength is noticed and as a consequence, the identified surplus staff are also to be shifted to needy colleges for better and fuller utilization of their services. The shifting is proposed to protect the welfare of the Aided Lecturers/Physical Directors/Librarians to avoid the stoppage of Grant-in-Aid to such posts and to avert retrenchment of staff, who otherwise will have to be terminated on account of uneconomic strength continuously for three years. On the other side, due to administrative and other reasons, number of lecturer posts are vacant in Private Aided Degree Colleges in the State. This has affected both the management and the students who are studying in these institutions.

The Government prescribed the minimum economic strength to Private Aided Rural / Urban College and based on the Audit Reports of the Department regarding the students strength and workload position, the Teaching Staff requirement was reviewed with the Correspondents / Principals of Private Aided Colleges and the Regional Joint Directors concerned and surplus lecturers were identified. The Govt. in G. O. Rt. No. 890 Edn., dated. 02.08.1996 have issued guidelines and in G. O. Rt. No. 962 Edn., dated. 10.06.1997 have issued permitted the Commissioner to shift the surplus teaching staff to needy colleges having sanctioned posts and requisite workload.

Keeping in view of the uneconomic strength in certain courses / groups, as the case may be, consequent on decrease in the workload in the subject concerned to decrease in the student enrolment, certain lecturers working in the Department / Subject of Private Aided Colleges were found surplus. The identified Surplus Lecturers of Private Aided Colleges are now transferred / redeployed to needy Private Aided / Government Colleges to work temporarily.

In view of the circumstances explained above, the Special Commissioner of Collegiate Education, A.P., Vijayawada has decided to transfer / redeploy the following surplus lecturer of Private Aided College to needy Private Aided / Government Colleges as detailed below.

Smt. Ch.Praveena, Lecturer in Physics, V.R.S. & Y.R.N.College, Chirala (Presently working at D.K.Govt. Degree College, Nellore on redeployment basis is Posted to Y.A. Govt. Degree College for Women, Chirala, Prakasam District. on redeployment Basis.

- 1) The Correspondents of the Private Aided Colleges concerned are requested to relieve the transferred / redeployed lecturers immediately on receipt of these proceedings to enable them to join duty immediately in the College to which they are transferred / redeployed. The transferred / redeployed Lecturer is directed to report at the new place allotted to him / her immediately after due relief from the parent college.
- 2) If the managements do not relieve the Lecturers / Physical Directors / Librarians who is now under orders of transferred / redeployment, the Grant-in-Aid for the post shall be withheld from 01-07-2017 onwards and the Correspondent has to pay the incumbent salary from their own funds.
- 3) The surplus identified and redeployed / transferred / Physical Director / lecturer shall be brought back to their parent college, if there is increase in the student strength and workload in the subject and need in the subsequent years, on receipt of a report from the parent College and after a review by the Department.
- 4) The surplus lecturer / Physical Director / Librarian now transferred / redeployed will continue to draw their salaries from the Grant-in-Aid released to his parental College after obtaining the attendance certificate from the Principal of Govt. College Concerned as he is working on Duty Basis.
- 5) The Correspondents of the concerned colleges are directed not to submit any type of proposals for seeking permission to fill up the above vacant posts in place of redeployed staff to other colleges, any deviation will be viewed seriously and action will be initiated against the Principal and Correspondent of the concerned colleges for sending such proposals
- 6) The Regional Joint Directors of Collegiate Education concerned are directed to maintain separate register in the R.J.D. office of those who are redeployed from the parent college to the newly posted college (College-wise)

The Correspondents of Private Aided Colleges concerned are requested to report / intimate the date of relief and joining to the Special Commissioner of Collegiate Education / Regional Joint Directors of Collegiate Education / Principals of Identified Govt. Colleges concerned promptly.



An agreement made on 9th day of OCTOBER 2020 between college planning and Development Council (CPDC) of Y.A. Govt. College for Women, Chirala college, Represented by President (First Part) and Smt. G. Jyothsna Lecturer in Physics (Second part).

NOW, THEREFORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS:



1. That the party to the second part agrees to perform the teaching work in accordance with the curriculum of the University for the course from (date of permission) 01-06-2020 to 31-05-2021, (12 months with 10 days break from 11.5.2021 to 20.05.2021) (or) the last day of instruction of University concerned whichever is earlier and that the party to the second part shall carry out further instructions given to him by the college planning and Development Council (CPDC) from time to time in the discharge of his/her duties as a teacher, mentioned in para 1 above.
2. That the party to the second part agrees after being informed that he/she is fully aware of the fact that his/her service is being taken not to fill any vacancy either on temporary or permanent basis, that he/she will be paid a consolidated amount per month during the contract period that his/her contract shall automatically comes to an end on expiry of the said period or on report of a regular lecturer to duty in that subject whichever is earlier. The contract shall not be treated as continuing for the past but as a new contractual agreement for limited duration.
3. That the contract is terminable by the party of the first part i.e., college planning and development council at any time during the said period and the party of the second part in such case is entitled to only prorata amount till such time. In case of termination during the said period for any reasons, the party of the second part is not entitled to question the correctness of the decision of the college Planning and Development Council.

10. That the relationship between the two parties is purely contractual and strictly as per the terms mentioned above.





NOW THERE FORE THIS AGREEMENT WITNESS AS FOLLOWS:




