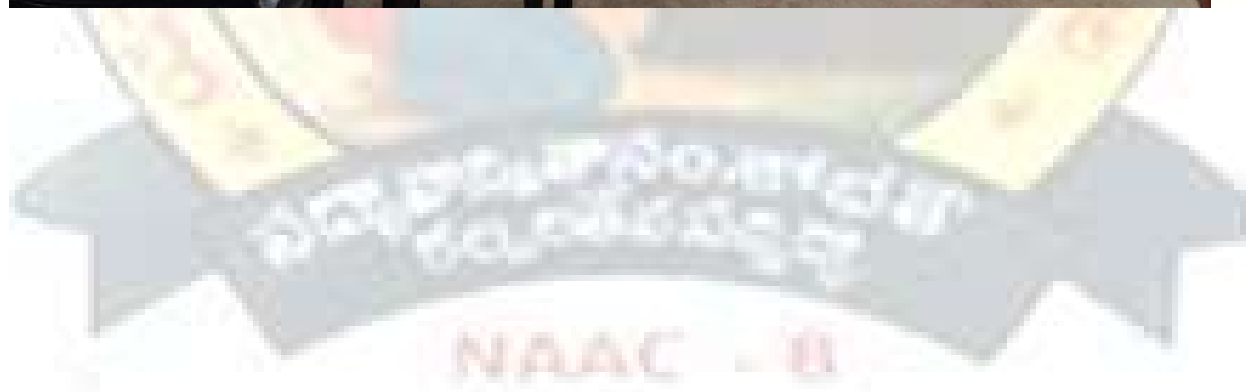
Objectives

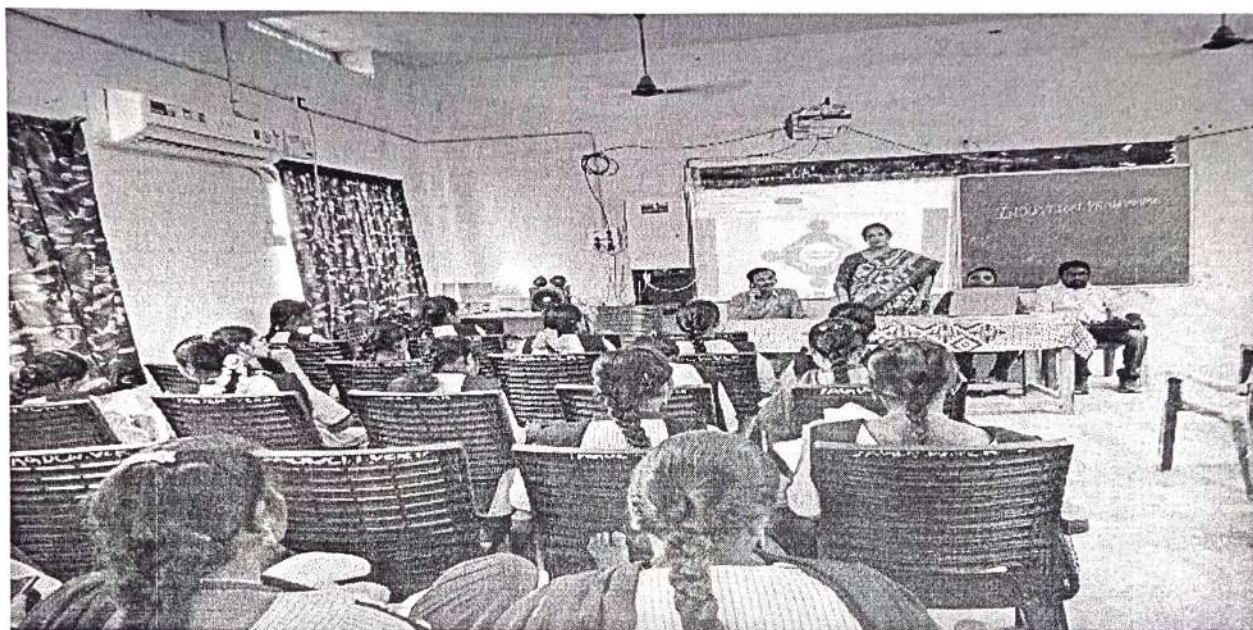

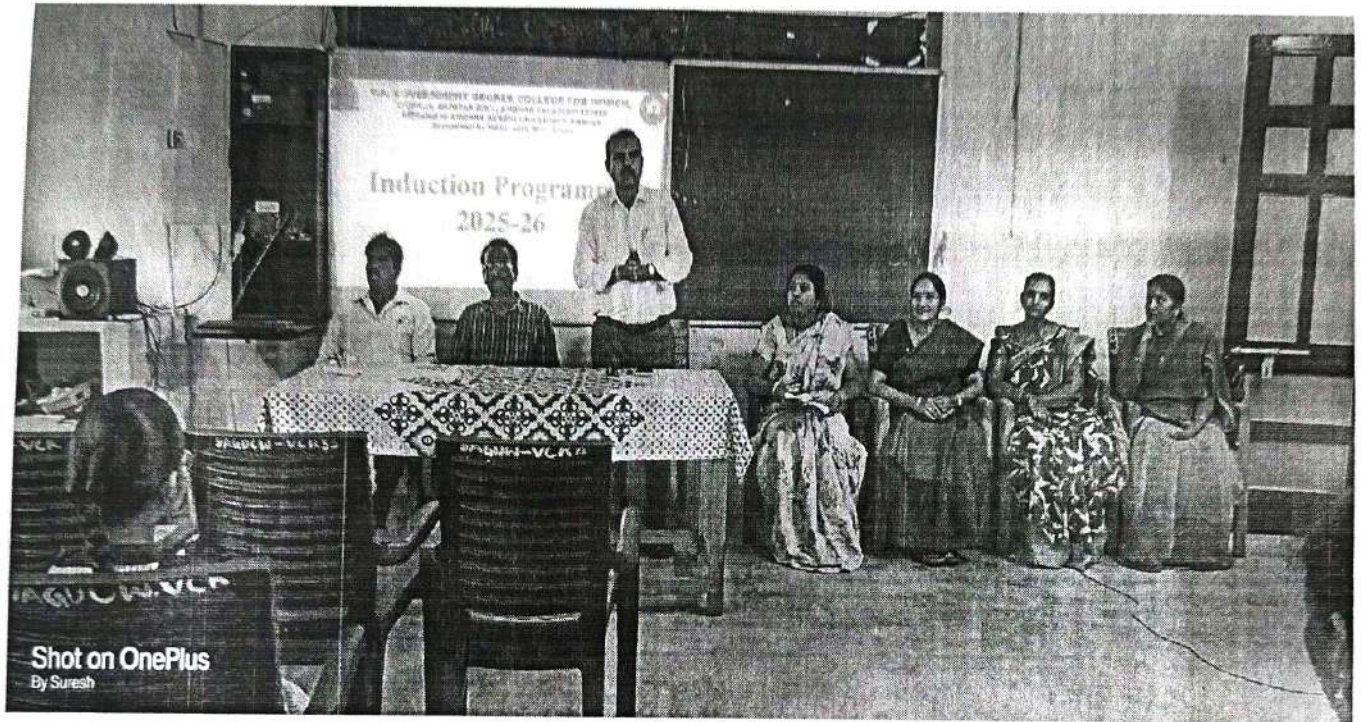

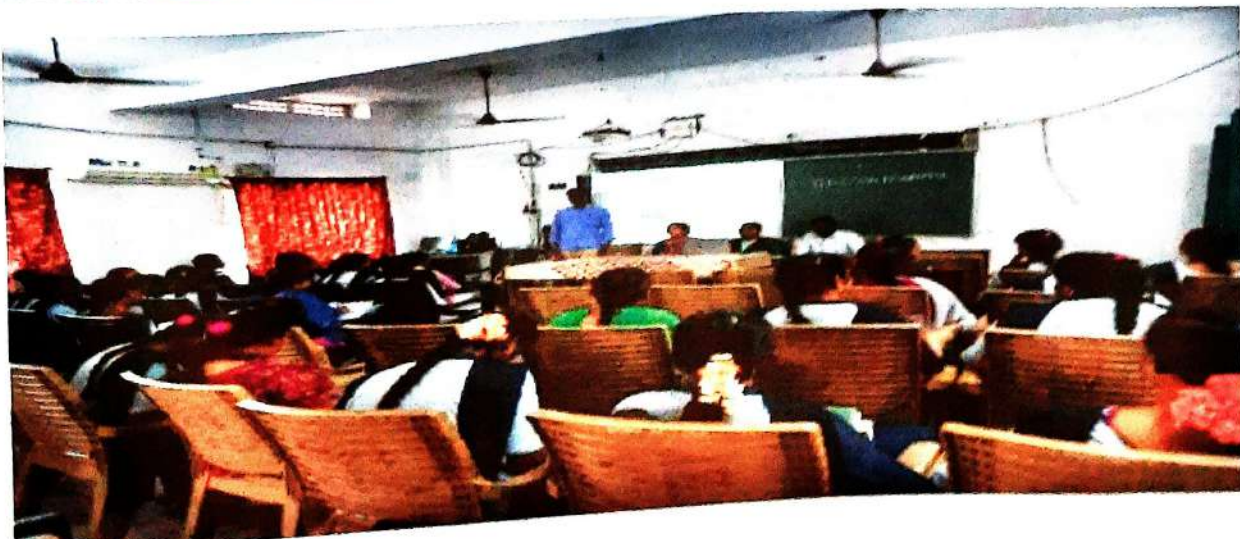

Report:

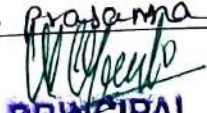
The Induction Programme was conducted in the digital classroom with the participation of 45 students. The programme aimed at familiarising students with the institutional environment and academic structure.
