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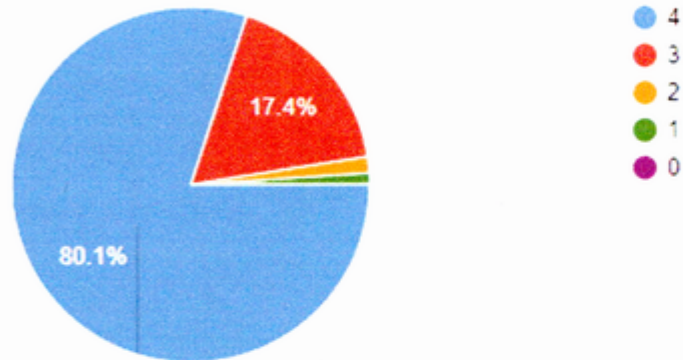

ANALYSIS ON STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY FOR THE YEAR 2021-22

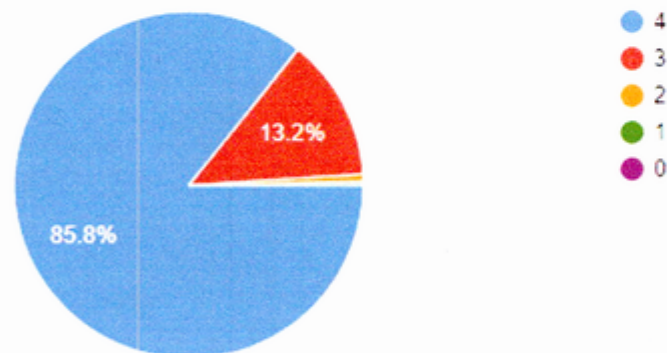
1 Coverage of the syllabus:

Most of the teachers will complete the syllabus within the stipulated period in our college and it is a regular practice. Out of the collected samples 80.1% of the students are satisfied with the coverage of the syllabus and gave 4 points. 17.4% of the students gave 3 points.



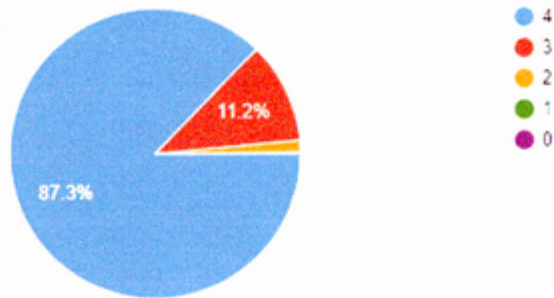
2 Teacher preparation for the classes:

85.8% of the students are happy with the teachers in their preparation for the class in their subject concern. They opted first option and gave 4 points. 13.2% of the students opted for second option and awarded 3 points. Only 1.8% of students chose the third option and gave 2 points in this regard.



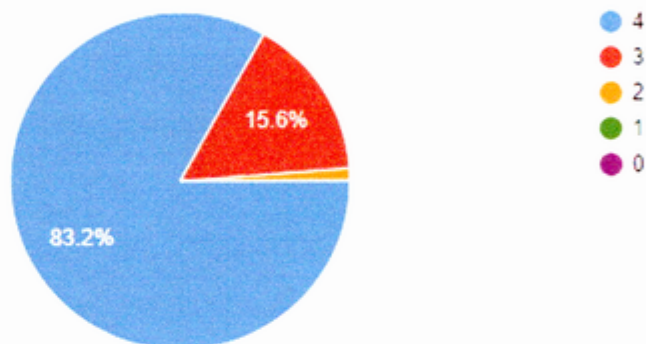
3 **Ability of teacher in communication:**

87.3% of the students opined that their teachers are always effective at communication in the class. They gave 4 points for the teachers. 12.0% of the students chose 'sometime effective' and gave 3 points.



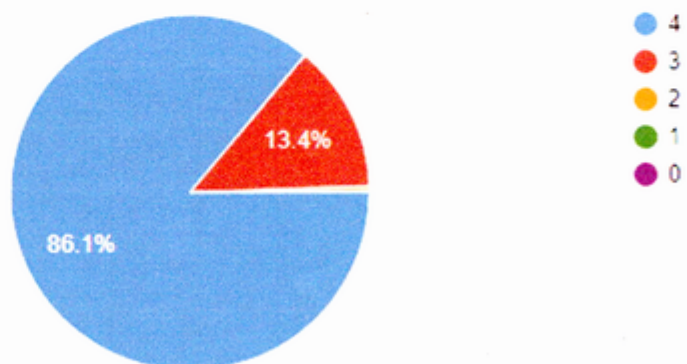
4 **Teacher's approach in best teaching:**

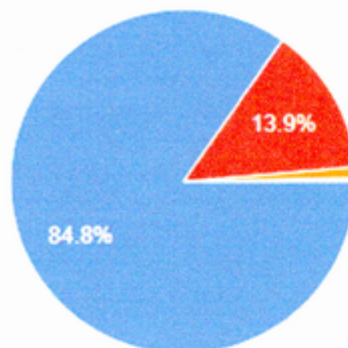
5 **Fairness in internal evaluation:**

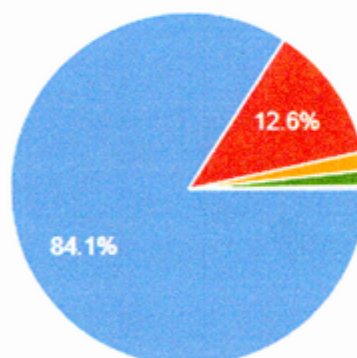
6 **Discussion about the performance in assignments:**

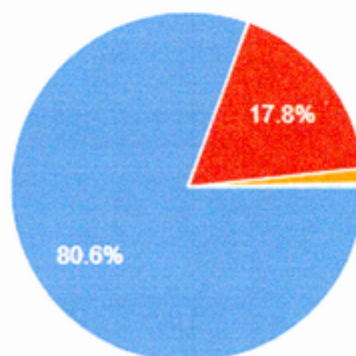
7 **Interest in arranging field visits for students:**

8 **Cognitive, social and emotional growth:**

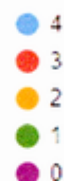
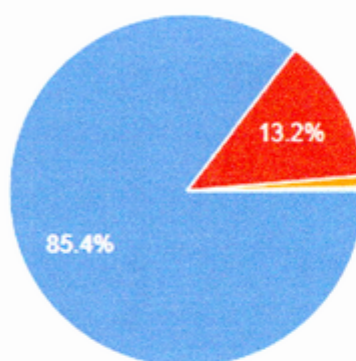
The classroom teaching generally involved with various contemporary issues. Being a women's college, our teaching staff trains the students how to overcome various academic, social and emotional problems.

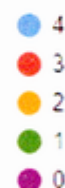
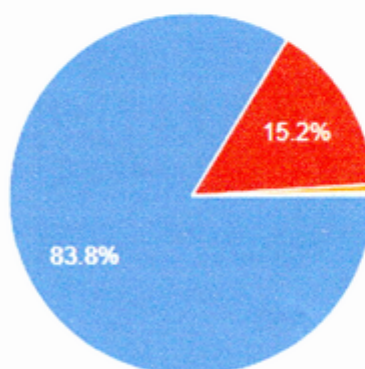
9 **Multiple opportunities to learn and grow:**

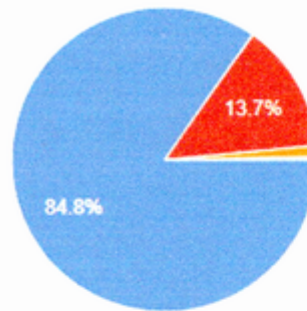
10 **Competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes:**

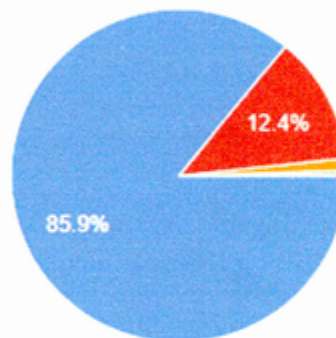
11 **Necessary follow-up with an assigned task:**

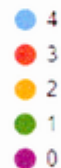
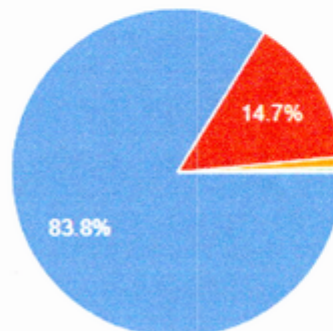
12 **The teacher illustrates the concepts through examples and applications:**

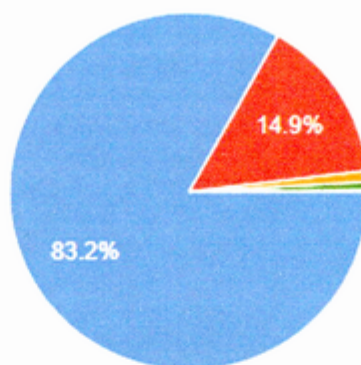
13 **Teacher identifies your strengths and encourage:**

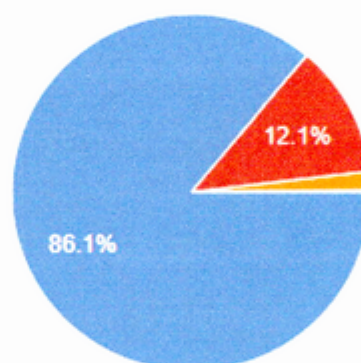
14 Teacher is able to identify your weaknesses:

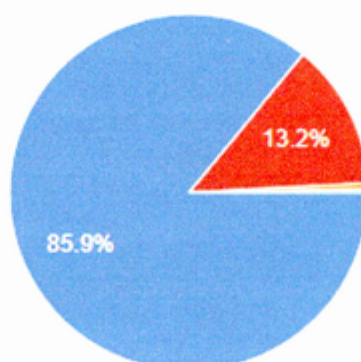
15 Review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process:

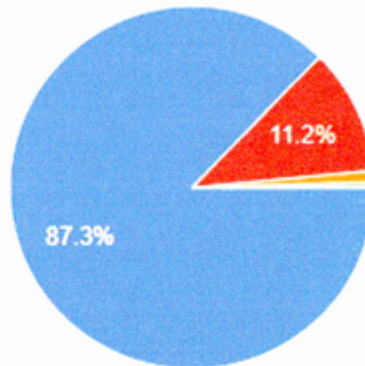
16 Student centric methods:

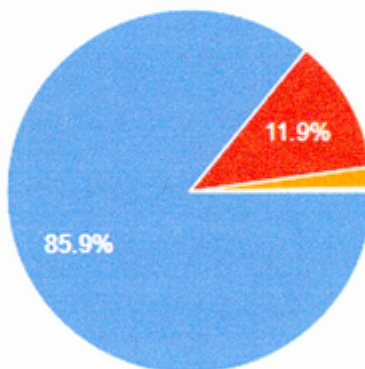
17 Encourages you to participate in extracurricular activities:

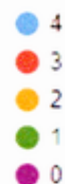
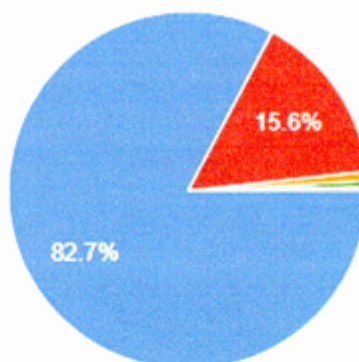
18 Inculcate soft skills life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work:

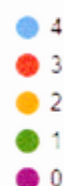
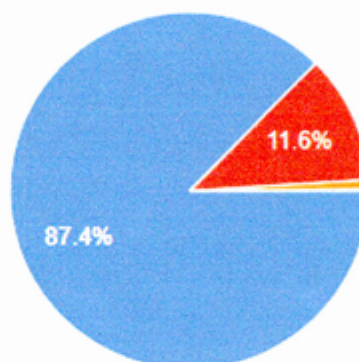
19 **Uses ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia:**
